4. CEO Report

Jan Pepper, *CEO*, provided a report that covered the following topics: staffing updates including our three new hires and one open position, the CC Power Long Duration Storage Project timing update, and a proposed schedule change for the Board Retreat schedule.

Committee Members showed their support for proposing moving the Board Retreat to Thursday during the regularly scheduled meetings as opposed to Saturday mornings.

5. Executive Committee Debrief on Peninsula Clean Energy Board Retreat held on September 25, 2021 (Discussion)

Jan Pepper, CEO, introduced the debrief of Peninsula Clean Energy's Board Retreat which was held on September 25, 2021.

Committee Members discussed the importance of our two strategic priorities: design a power portfolio that is sourced by 100% carbon-free\* energy by 2025 that aligns supply and consumer demand on a 24 x 7 basis and contribute to Peninsula Clean Energy member jurisdictions reaching the state's goal to be 100% greenhouse gas-free by 2045.

Director Hale shared reflections on the retreat and recapped an email that was sent to Jan Pepper including thoughts on how to stay on track to meet these goals, transportation focus, programs and budget in relation to emission reductions, public education and a potential community advisory marketing group.

Committee Members discussed the span of control over these goals, Peninsula Clean Energy rates, transportation methods to reduce emissions, Diversity, Equity, Accessibility and Inclusion (DEAI) work, changing demand habits, and the potential for a dashboard to monitor progress.

# 6. Approval of 2022 Executive Committee Schedule of Meetings (Action)

Nelly Wogberg, Board Clerk, explained the proposed 2022 Executive Committee Meeting Schedule, to be in compliance with AB 361 guidelines and including a change to the start time of meetings that coincide with Board of Directors meetings to begin at 6:20 p.m. instead of 6:25 p.m. as was printed in the meeting packet.

Committee Members discussed cancelling a meeting during the summer but decided that the schedule would allow staff greater flexibility for approving contracts as needed.
